

ADULT CONDITIONAL SENTENCE ORDER CONDITIONS

Statutory conditions:

1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour.
2. Appear before the court when required to do so.
3. Report as the Court directs (see Reporting in the Additional Conditions) in person to a supervisor and thereafter report when required by the supervisor and in a manner directed by the supervisor.
4. Remain in Ontario unless you have prior written permission from the Court or the supervisor to leave the province.
5. Notify the court or supervisor in advance of any change of name or address and promptly notify the court or supervisor of any change in employment or occupation

Statutory conditions will automatically print on all CSO'S

1. Reporting

1. Report in person to a supervisor once only today
 - Immediately within ____ working days of your release from custody
 - and after that, at all times and places as directed by the supervisor or any person authorized by a supervisor to assist in your supervision
2. Your reporting requirement ends when you have satisfied your supervisor that you have:
 - paid the restitution in full
 - completed all of your community service hours
 - completed all of your counselling

5. Electronic Supervision Program

- 1. You shall report immediately to _____ for the purpose of arranging your enrolment in the Electronic Supervision Program.
- 2. You shall participate and abide by the rules and regulations of that program as required by your Conditional Sentence Supervisor and/or designated Electronic Supervision Resource Officer for the purpose of monitoring your house arrest, home curfew, residence restriction, etc.

You shall permit the Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services staff and/or persons who are authorized by the Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services associated with the Electronic Supervision Program to enter your residence for the purpose of setting up, installing, maintaining, repairing or removing the Electronic Supervision Program equipment.
5. You shall make yourself available either by phone or in person as may be required at any time during house arrest/home confinement/curfew and in particular:
 - a. You shall answer the phone at any time during house arrest/home confinement/curfew and
 - b. Present yourself to Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services staff, police services and/or persons who are authorized by the Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services associated with the Electronic Supervision Program at the door of your residence at any time during house arrest/home confinement/curfew for the purpose of confirming your presence and compliance.
6. You shall reside at an address approved by your Conditional Sentence Supervisor and/or designate and not change your address without prior written permission of your Supervisor.
7. You shall permit Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services staff and/or police services in your residence during the investigation of any alerts; either technical (i.e. transmitter battery low) or compliance issue (i.e. subject leaving during curfew), generated while on the Electronic Supervision Program.
8. Obey curfew: be in your place of residence between the hours of ____and____ unless permission in writing is obtained from the Conditional Sentence Supervisor or designate.
9. You must remain in your own residence except for the purpose of school attendance, employment, medical appointment, religious services and legal obligations regarding compliance with this sentence/order. You shall provide the supervisor with your schedule of school and/or work hours, medical appointments and religious services. The supervisor will incorporate these into a written letter of permission to be out of the residence and that letter shall be carried by you on your person at all times while out of the residence.
10. You may obtain from the supervisor written permission to be absent from the residence for any other reason deemed appropriate by the supervisor. You shall carry such written permission on your person at all times while out of the residence.
