

# ADULT PROBATION CONDITIONS

## Statutory conditions:

1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour
2. Appear before the court when required to do so
3. Notify the court or probation officer in advance of any change of name of address and promptly notify the court or probation officer of any change in employment or occupation

***Statutory conditions will automatically print on all Probation Orders***

## 1. Intermittent Sentence Only

1.  You must appear at the jail to serve your intermittent sentence on time, in a sober condition, with a blood alcohol concentration of zero, and not under the influence of or in possession of any controlled substance unless you are taking that controlled substance pursuant to a lawfully obtained prescription.

## 2. Reporting

## 9. Weapons and Permits

Do not possess any weapon(s) as defined by the Criminal Code (for example: a BB gun, pellet gun, firearm, imitation firearm, cross-bow, prohibited or restricted weapon or device, ammunition or explosive substance or anything designed to be used or intended for use to cause death or injury or to threaten or intimidate any person)

## 12. Community Service
